2015 BUS PASSES

If you have a child in **Year 2 this year** who has a bus pass and you would like them to have a pass next year (Year 3 2015), you will need to complete a new application form. Passes do not carry over from infants to primary. Any student who has changed address or will change address before the 2015 school year commences should also complete a new application form. Please ensure you tick the box for travel **next** year.

Remember, your child is eligible for a bus pass if:

they are an infant student (K-2) **OR** they are in primary (3-6) and live outside the 1.6 km radius from the school.
