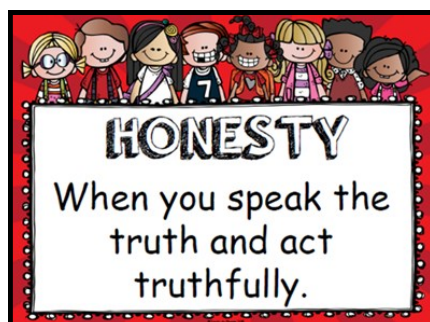
Wellbeing News!!
